Information and guidelines for the applicant

Marion McCall OAM has donated this award to financially assist an Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander woman who is resident in and a citizen of Australia TO TRAIN UP TO SOLO FLYING STANDARD.

Value :
\$3,750

Applications close :
Annually 31st January

Conditions :

The applicant must:

- Be a female resident of Australia, and an Australian citizen
- Be an Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander
- Be medically fit and able to pass a pilot medical *see below*
- Complete and sign the application form
- The training flights must be completed within 12 months of receiving the award (an extension may be granted at the discretion of the panel) *see below*
- Membership of AWPA is not a requirement but the successful applicant will be expected to join AWPA if not already a member.

Guidelines for Applicants:

- Applicants may only apply for TWO AWPA scholarships in any one year.
- Applicants must be able to identify and confirm their Aboriginal/ Torres Strait Islander status.
- The scholarship winner must pass a pilot medical prior to using scholarship funds for flight training. A copy of the certificate must be submitted to the selection panel. If required, the scholarship winner may claim the cost of the pilot medical from the scholarship funds provided she passes the medical evaluation.
- Should the winner of the scholarship not pass the pilot medical the scholarship will be forfeited.

General information:

The Selection Panel's decision will be final.

In the event that the panel finds no suitable applicant, the money will be held over to the following year.

Funds will be paid to the flying school where the training is taking place, on receipt of invoices raised.

The successful applicant will have from 1st February in the year the scholarship is granted until 30th June the following year to complete the flying.

Application form and all supporting documents will be considered confidential and will be destroyed after selection unless a request is made for their return.

Applications must be submitted by 31st January, 2021.
