SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Australian Women Pilots' Association, through the sponsorship of Air BP, is pleased to make this scholarship available. To be awarded on a dollar for dollar basis, the scholarship is to assist a female pilot to meet the costs of an Air Transport Pilot Licence theory course.

The scholarship winner will be announced at the AWPA Annual Conference Presentation dinner on Saturday 24 April 2021 in Broken Hill NSW.

Minimum Requirements

1. 300 hours total flying time.
2. Australian Commercial Pilot Licence.
3. Current CASA Class 1 Medical.

Note: AWPA membership is not a requirement.

Applications

In compiling your application, you will be required to:

- complete the relevant application form
- write a short essay on why you deserve to win this scholarship
- provide two referees – one personal and one involved with aviation.

In addition, applications must include copies of the following items:

- Both sides (ie. left and right hand sides) of the last 2 pages of your open pilot's log book
- Your Commercial Pilot Licence
- Your CASA Class 1 Medical which must be current.

APPLICATIONS CLOSE 31 JANUARY 2021

General Conditions

1. The scholarship funds will be available from 24 April 2021 to 30 June 2022. However, eligible expenses incurred from the time that applications close may be claimed as well. So the effective period of the scholarship is from 1 February 2021 through to 30 June 2022.
2. The scholarship is personal to the recipient and cannot be transferred to another person, or be cashed in, in the event of inability to continue studying for any reason.
3. The scholarship will pay up to \$1,000 on a dollar for dollar basis to the recipient. The funds will be paid once copies of itemised invoices and receipts made out to the recipient for any ATPL subject, in which a PASS has been achieved, are received by the AWPA National Treasurer.
4. The scholarship organisers:
 - a) will not extend the value of the scholarship to account for any changes in costs of ATPL courses;
 - b) will make a decision as to the selection of the recipient that is final;
 - c) reserve the right not to present the scholarship if in the judgment of the selection panel none of the applicants are deemed suitable.

Submission

Please note that incomplete applications will not be considered – a checklist is provided as part of the application form to help guard against this.

Applications must be submitted both electronically in **PDF format** and in hard copy by post. Please do not bind the paper copy or put it in any sort of presentation folder.

Note that the total file size of the electronic version must not exceed 5 MB.

Applications close on 31 January 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.
