

NANCY-BIRD WALTON MEMORIAL TROPHY

Nomination Guidelines

The Nancy-Bird Walton Memorial Trophy is for the **“most noteworthy contribution to aviation by a woman of Australasia”**.

Nominations, with citations, must be received by the incumbent National Vice President no later than 31 January in the nomination year.

Late nominations will not be accepted.

All nominations are to be submitted on the nomination form designed for the Nancy-Bird Walton Memorial Trophy which can be obtained from the National Vice President or via the AWPA website. There can be only one nominee per nomination form. The citation forms part of the nomination.

The nominee's name must be on the top of each page of the citation. The citation should not exceed 800 words, with a minimum of 700 words, and must clearly state the “noteworthy” contribution with supporting rationale.

Nominations may be submitted by the State or Territory representing the nominee or by a current individual member. The State, Territory or individual member may nominate more than one person in any one year. Each nomination must have a nominator and a seconder, whether nominated by the State or Territory or by an individual member.

No individual may nominate herself. All nominations must be proposed and seconded by persons other than the nominee.

Nomination is not restricted to members of the Australian Women Pilots' Association.

Nomination is not restricted to a “contribution” made only during the previous year.

The trophy is awarded for the most noteworthy contribution to aviation and is not awarded based on the personal achievements of the nominee if those achievements do not contribute to aviation at large.

Only one nomination per year can be successful. The decision of the selection panel in the choice of the trophy recipient shall be final.

No correspondence may be entered into with respect to the decision of the panel.

The Nancy-Bird Walton Memorial Trophy does not have to be awarded each year.

The official presentation of the trophy will be made at the Annual AWPA Presentation function.
