Conditions :

The applicant must :

- Be resident in South Australia or Northern Territory
- Be a current member of AWPA
- Have belonged to the SA-NT branch of AWPA for a minimum of two years
- Have a current medical (as applicable to your sector of aviation)
- Fill in and sign the application form
- The flights must be completed within 12 months of receiving the award (an extension may be granted at the discretion of the panel) *see below*

Guidelines for Applicant :

Applicants may apply for no more than 2 AWPA scholarships in any one year.

Your application including the form on the website should include an explanation in not more than 200 - 250 words stating your reasons for applying for the scholarship.

General information :

The successful applicant will have from 1st June in the year the grant is awarded until 30th June the following year to complete the flying. The grant recipient will provide a report by 31st July the following year detailing how the funds were used.

Application form and all supporting documents will be considered confidential and destroyed after selection unless a request is made for their return.

The winner will be announced at the presentation dinner held during the Australian Women Pilots' Association Annual Conference, and the grant presented at the SA-NT Branch AGM.

Applications must be received by 31st January, 2021.
