**Applications must be submitted electronically in PDF format – if more than one document all must be in PDF format.** Applications that include imaging (eg. JPEG) or word processing (eg. Word) formats will not be accepted.

Note that the total file size of the application – if more than one document add all the individual sizes together – must not exceed 5 MB.

**Any application exceeding 5 MB or which is not in PDF format will not be accepted.**

**DO NOT LEAVE THIS TO THE LAST MINUTE** in case technical help is required.

**NOTE: If any details are found to be incorrect the successful candidate may forfeit the scholarship.**
