Applications must be submitted electronically in PDF format – if more than one document all must be in PDF format. Applications that include imaging (eg. JPEG) or word processing (eg Word) formats will not be accepted.

Note that the total file size of the application – if more than one document add all the individual sizes together – must not exceed 5 MB.

Any application exceeding 5 MB or which is not in PDF format will not be accepted.

DO NOT LEAVE THIS TO THE LAST MINUTE in case technical help is required.
