- 3) Copy of CASA Aviation Class 1 or 2 medical – Note that out of currency medicals will result in rejection of the application.

- 4) Copy of the last two pages of your pilot’s logbook recording flying experience. Copy both sides (left & right sides) of each of the last two open pages of your logbook. Ensure that any completed pages have been verified in accordance with your flying school's procedures, eg signed by your instructor or HOO/CFI.

In addition, **Category 2** applicants must provide certification from their Chief Pilot or HOO/CFI that they have completed five hours cross-country flight time as pilot in command.

Section 5 – Letter of Recommendation

Please attach a recent reference from a flying instructor or other aviation person who can attest to both your character and personality and your interests and aspirations in regard to aviation. Do not ask relatives or any other person connected to you personally to provide this reference. Recommendation letters must bear the date on which they were written, be signed, and include the length of time the referee has known you and in what capacity.

1. Your plan for achieving your CPL and the strategies you will adopt to implement that plan.
2. Your present and future goals, and how you anticipate achieving them.
3. How you anticipate obtaining your first flying job.

Section 7 – Declaration

I acknowledge and accept that neither Australian Women Pilots' Association nor Airservices Australia or their respective office bearers, members or employees, will be under any liability whatsoever during any phase of the scholarship arising from or in any way relating to the scholarship or the training pursued by me, should I be awarded this scholarship.

- AWPA membership – 2022 membership paid

Applications must be submitted electronically in PDF format – if more than one document all must be in PDF format. Applications that include imaging (eg JPEG) or word processing (eg Word) formats will not be accepted.

Note that the total file size of the application – if more than one document add all the individual sizes together – must not exceed 5 MB.

Any application exceeding 5 MB or which is not in PDF format will not be accepted.

DO NOT LEAVE THIS TO THE LAST MINUTE in case technical help is required.

NOTE: If any details are found to be incorrect the successful candidate may forfeit the scholarship.
