AWPA WA BRANCH AVIATION AWARD 2023 – \$2,000

The aim of this award is to assist any female student pilot in training for the Recreational Pilot Licence (RPL), Private Pilot Licence (PPL), RA-Aus Pilot Certificate, RA-Aus Navigation Endorsement or Gliding Certificate, thereby promoting the Australian Women Pilots' Association.

Conditions:

The Applicant must:

- Be female, membership of AWPA is **NOT** required
- Have resided in WA for a minimum of 12 months
- Hold a current aviation medical certificate appropriate to qualification
- Have completed her first solo flight
- Utilise the award within 12 months of receipt – (An extension of time may be granted at the discretion of the Selection Panel provided an application for extension is made before the end of the 12-month period)

The Award will be paid on a 'dollar for dollar' basis. This means the applicant will be required to pay 50% of her training costs until the \$2,000 award is expended. The Selection Panel's decision will be final.

Selection Criteria:

To be considered for this award, the applicant should write a statement of not more than 400 words demonstrating her:

- Enthusiasm for and interest in aviation,
- Commitment to furthering her flying training, and
- Future flying ambitions.

Guidelines for Applicant:

Your application including the form on the website should include:

- Two written references; one from an instructor with whom you have flown and one from a personal referee (cannot both be from your flying school)
- A summary of your flying training to date (you may be asked to present your logbook)
- The document addressing the selection criteria.

General Information:

The selection panel will consist of three members; the State President of AWPA or her nominee, a representative from the aviation industry and a scholarship committee member.

Applicants may be asked for a phone interview with the selection panel. In the event the panel finds no suitable applicant, the money will be held over to the following year. The application form and all supporting documents will be considered confidential and will be destroyed after selection unless a request is made for their return.
