

AWPA SA-NT Memorial Incentive Grant SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

To financially assist a current AWPA member resident in South Australia or Northern Territory in any commendable aviation endeavour.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- 1. Have a current medical (as applicable to your sector in aviation)
- 2. Be a resident in South Australia or Northern Territory
- 3. Must be an Australian citizen, a permanent resident or reside in Australia
- 4. Be a current member of AWPA and
- 5. Have belonged to AWPA for a minimum of 2 years and preferably the SA-NT Branch.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

All scholarship applications must include the following items:

- 1. Your application should include an explanation in not more than 500 words stating your reasons for applying for the scholarship.
- 2. Copy of current CASA aviation Class 1 or 2 medical
- 3. Evidence of your Australian Citizenship, Permanent Residency or Australian residential address
- 4. Evidence of your SA or NT residential address

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS:

- 1. The successful applicant will have from 1st June in the year the grant is awarded until 30th June the following year to use the funds.
- The winner will be announced at the presentation dinner held during the Australian Women Pilots' Association Annual Conference, and the grant presented at the SA-NT Branch Annual Meeting.
- 3. Scholarship funds may either be paid directly to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator or the applicant may have scholarships funds reimbursed to them if proof of payment to a Part 141 or 142 Fight Training Operator is provided.
