

AUSTRALIAN WOMEN PILOTS' ASSOCIATION GLIDING AWARD

INFORMATION

Applications close on 17 March 2026

This award is made either for the most meritorious gliding flight carried out by a female glider pilot during the previous year, or for an outstanding contribution to the advancement of gliding in Australia.

You must be recommended for this award by a GFA Instructor, CFI/HOO, NGS Instructor or higher qualified representative of The Gliding Federation of Australia and they must sight and sign your essay and sign below as recognition of recommendation.

Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Must be a current financial member of the Gliding Australia and an Australian Gliding Club
- 2. Must be an Australian citizen, a permanent resident or reside in Australia
- 3. Write a short essay (no more than 500 words) describing the flight, or state the form of your or the nominee's outstanding contribution to the advancement of gliding in Australia and why you believe you/they should receive this award.

Supporting Documentation

- 1. Evidence of your Gliding Australia and Gliding club membership
- 2. Evidence of your Australian Citizenship, Permanent residency or Australian residential address
- 3. Essay
