



AWPA MARION MCCALL OAM SCHOLARSHIP

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

To financially assist an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander woman who is resident in and a citizen of Australia to train up to the level of Solo Flight. This scholarship is valued at \$5,000.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

1. Applicant must be an Australian citizen, a permanent resident or reside in Australia
2. Be medically fit and able to pass a pilot medical
3. Be a female Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander person

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

- All scholarship applications must include the following items:
- Your essay of no more than 500 words. Please explain why you would like to receive this scholarship.
- Evidence of Australian Citizenship, and Australian residential address

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS:

1. I must confirm my status as an Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander
2. A pilot medical must be passed prior to commencing flight training. Scholarship funds may be used for this purpose if required.
3. The term of the scholarship ends on 30 June, 2028
4. Any funds not used by me during the term of the Scholarship will be forfeited
5. A progress report from my flying school is required in December 2027
6. A final report prepared by me is required by 30 June, 2028
7. Scholarship funds may either be paid directly to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator, or an RAAus Training provider or the applicant may have scholarships funds reimbursed to them if proof of payment to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator or RAAus training provider is provided.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS:

Applications are to be submitted electronically via the website.

Closure date: **31st of January 2027**

Note: Late applications will not be accepted.
