INFORMATION

To provide financial assistance for a conversion from an RA-Aus Recreational Pilot Certificate to Private Pilot Licence (PPL).

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- AWPAA membership for a minimum of 12 months by close of applications
- 2027 AWPAA membership dues paid by 31 January 2027
- Be at least 20 years of age by close of applications
- Hold a current Special Class 2 medical or above - provide a copy
- Provide a copy of the last 2 pages – both sides – of your logbook
- Provide a copy of your Recreational Pilot Certificate
- PPL to be successfully completed by 30 June 2028.
- Must be an Australian citizen, a permanent resident or reside in Australia
- Provided an essay of no more than 500 words, explaining why you are deserving of the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS:

The scholarship is valued at up to **\$3000**. Scholarship funds are to be used for flying training only.

The recipient will be able to claim against the scholarship once she has achieved her PPL. The scholarship term commences at announcement on 3rd April 2027 and ends 30 June 2028. Additionally, any relevant training conducted immediately after applications close may be claimed as well. This effectively widens the term of the scholarship from 1 February 2027 to 30 June 2028, although the PPL must be achieved by the end of June 2028.

Funds will be paid on a dollar-for-dollar basis upon provision of relevant invoices and proof of passing PPL flight test.

APPLICATIONS CLOSE 31 JANUARY 2027

Scholarship funds may either be paid directly to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator, or an RAAus Training provider or the applicant may have scholarships funds reimbursed to them if proof of payment to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator or RAAus training provider is provided.

The successful applicant will be announced at the Awards and Presentation Dinner on 3rd of April 2027 in Orange NSW.
