Applications close 17 March 2027

To be awarded to a female glider pilot to assist with enhancing her cross-country skills.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

1. The scholarship funds will be available from 9th of May 2027 to 30th of June 2028. However, eligible expenses incurred from the time that applications close may be claimed as well. So the effective period of the scholarship is from 1st of February 2027 through to 30th of June 2028.
2. Applicant must be a current financial member of Gliding Australia and a gliding club
3. Must be an Australian citizen, a permanent resident or reside in Australia
4. Scholarship funds may either be paid directly to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator or the applicant may have scholarships funds reimbursed to them if proof of payment to a Part 141 or 142 Flight Training Operator is provided. Note: Gliding Clubs are not subject to the Part 141 or Part 142 requirement and the applicant can be reimbursed following proof of payment to a Gliding Club

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

All scholarship applications must include the following items:

1. Write a short essay (no longer than 500 words) on how you intend to use the scholarship if you are the successful applicant.
2. Evidence of your Australian citizenship, Permanent Residency or Australian residential address.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS:

Applications are to be submitted electronically via the website.

Closure date: **17th of March 2027**

Note: Late applications will not be accepted.
