**Entry Requirements**

**Applications close on 31 January 2021.**

This scholarship is open to all eligible members of the Australian Women Pilots' Association and may be used for fixed wing, rotary wing, gliding or balloon flight.

The intended use of the scholarship could include multi-engine class rating, design feature endorsement, flight review, PPL training, CPL training, private instrument rating (PIR), a flight activity endorsement, cross country gliding rating, aircraft type rating. It is intended that the scholarship be used for the attainment of one qualification and only for the intended purpose nominated on the application form.

This list is not exhaustive and is for guidance only.

**Note: This scholarship is not intended to be used to obtain an Instrument Rating (IR), Flight Instructor Rating (FI) or Night Visual Flight Rules rating (NVFR).**

**All Applicants**

1. Membership of AWPA - twelve months' minimum.
2. Hold a current Australian Medical (as applicable).
3. Hold a Recreational Pilot Licence (RPL) or higher **or** equivalent for gliding or ballooning.
4. Hold the appropriate licence or rating to undertake the proposed flight training.
5. For PPL, CPL or PIR, passes in the appropriate theory examinations must be completed by the nominated application closing date of 31 January 2021 (evidence to be provided).

**Entry Requirements**

6. Attach the following documents to the application form:
- The application form including essay
  - A copy of licence or log book entry indicating highest licence or rating held.
  - A copy of the result slips for theory examinations (as applicable)
  - A cost estimate from the proposed flying school or organisation providing the training

The application may be forwarded by email in the first instance. The email must include a scanned copy of all application documents mentioned above and received by COB 31 January 2021. A hard copy of the full application must be provided in addition (but need not be received by closing date).

Where the application is submitted in hard copy only, the application must be received by COB 31 January 2021.

All recipients of scholarships must have completed their training and have their licence endorsed within twelve months of receiving the award. This can be reviewed in extenuating circumstances upon application.

The scholarship monies will be paid to the flying training organisation of the recipient's choice on a dollar for dollar basis up to \$2500.

Proof of payment (statements and receipts) must be supplied.
